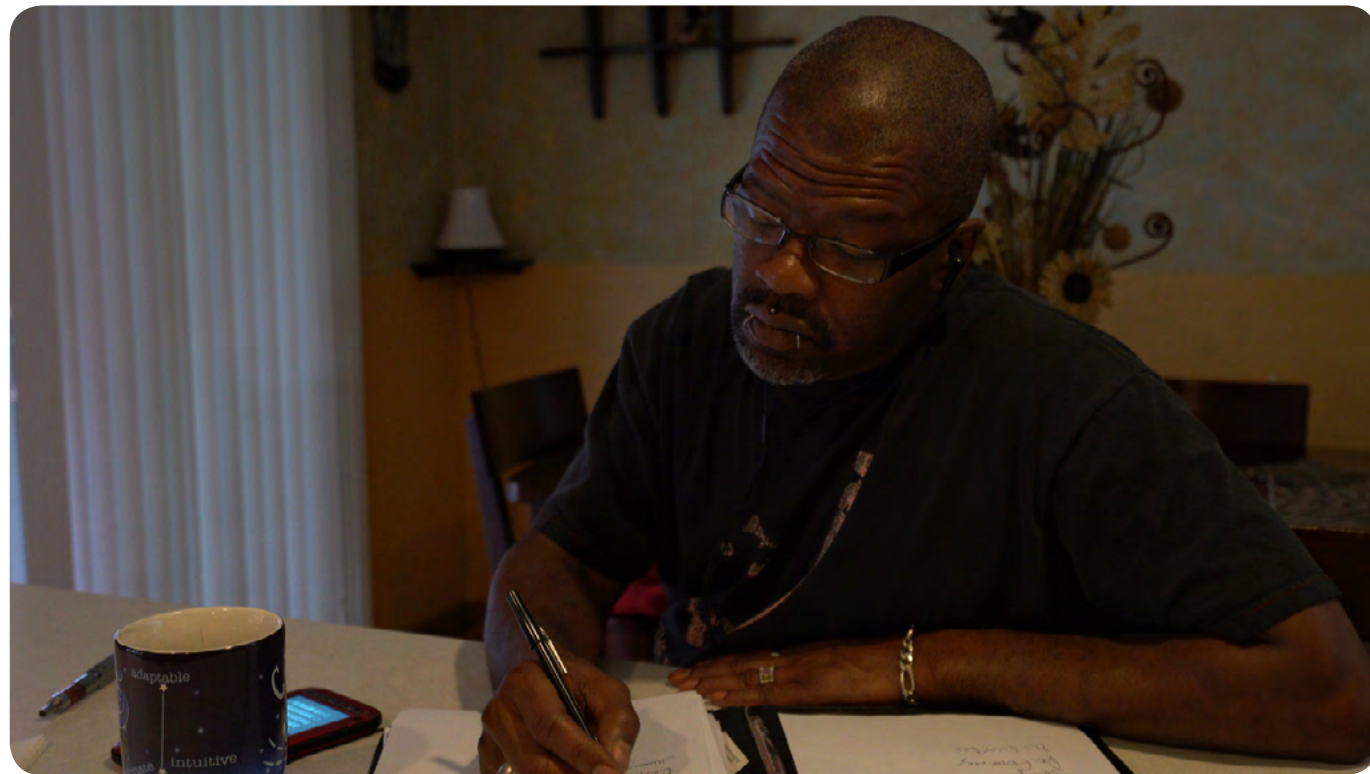

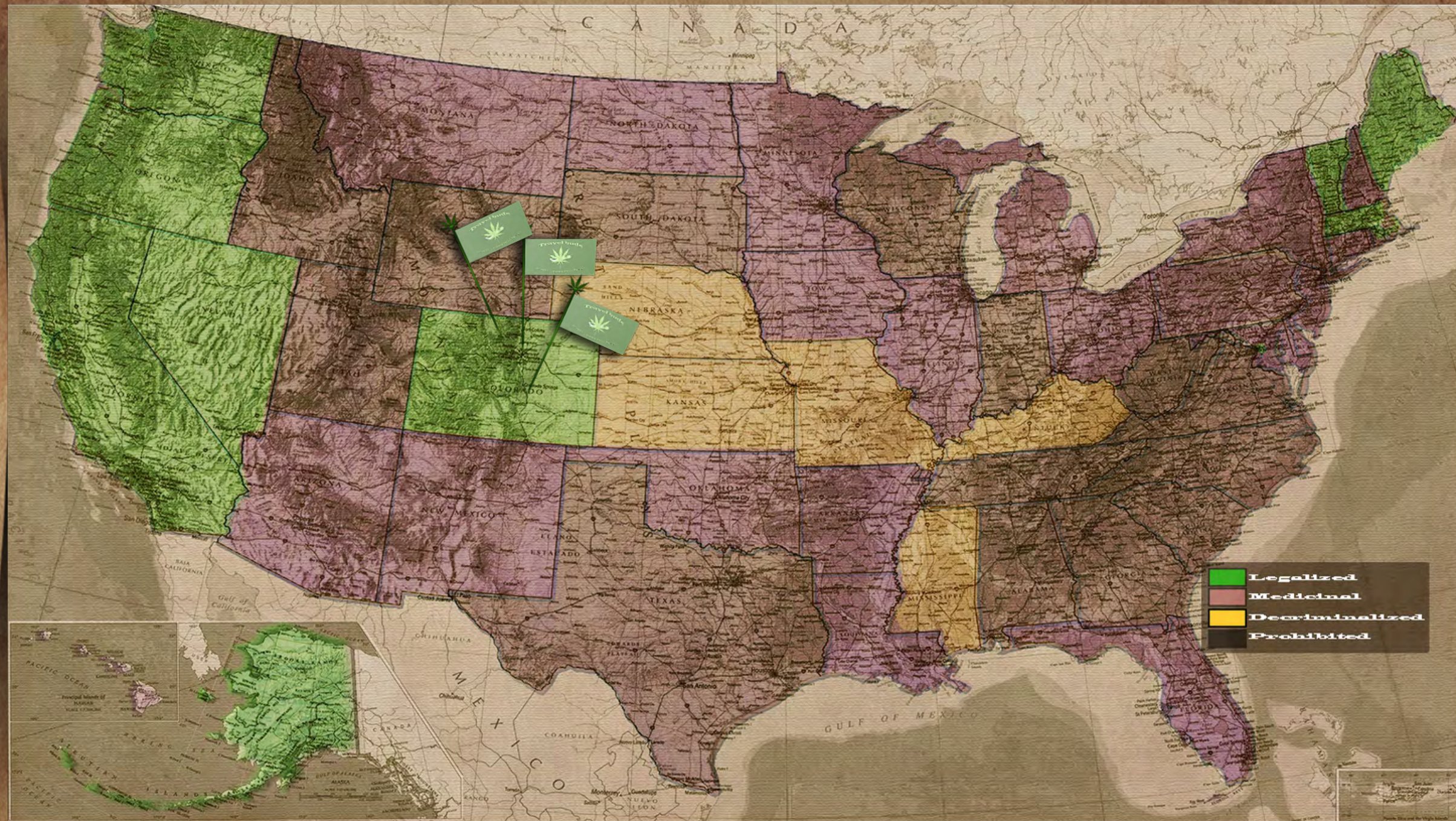

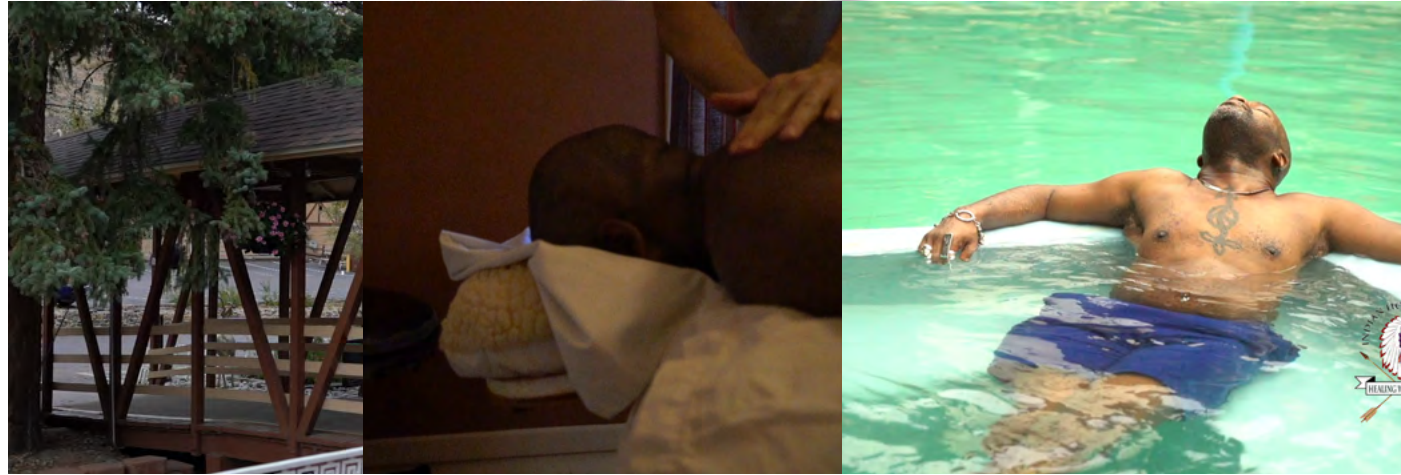


Medicine Man

With three locations in the Denver metro area, Andy and Pete Williams' Medicine Man is not only Denver's largest single marijuana dispensary, it's also a family owned and run business. Originally built in 1863 by Dr. E. M. Cummings, people have been enjoying the Indian Hot Springs for over 150 years. Today, Indian Hot Springs features mineral springs swimming pools, men and women's thermal caves, massage and spa services, and a spa room. In addition, Indian Hot Springs also has accommodations to fit everyone's needs including rooms at the Historic Main Resort Building, The Inn, The Lodge, or by renting free-standing cabins. Throughout its history, many famous (and infamous) people have visited Indian Hot Springs, including poet Walt Whitman, The Vanderbilts,

The Roosevelts, Frank and Jesse James, and William Bonny (better known as Billy the Kid). More recently, Clint Eastwood, Leon Russell and Bo Diddley have relaxed in the healing waters of the springs. Now, it's your turn to visit Indian Hot Springs. Featuring a family friendly pool and gender specific caves, private baths, or outdoor Jacuzzis, Indian Hot Springs is the perfect place to experience the natural mineral waters in Idaho Springs, Colorado.

As Joshiah Hess from Colorado Public Radio said in a recent interview, "This class allowed me to just let go. It was very laid-back and very welcoming with people of all ages." and said, "Maybe it was the weed, maybe it was the company, maybe it was the therapeutic nature of painting, but I was starting to feel a weight lifting off of my shoulders." So the next time you're in Denver, visit local painter Heidi Keyes for an intimate 2 hour smoking session in her home studio, while you follow along with her step-by-step instructions to create your own mind-altered masterpiece. Classes only hold up to 9 students and participants have to be 21 years of age or over to enroll.
